Call for revolt

Anarchist call from ZAD Rheinland on the upcoming eviction attempt

It is the beginning of October. We are in the middle of autumn, we have the relaxed time of summer behind us. And in just a few days there will be another time, one that is no longer calm, in which we can no longer spend hours exchanging ideas. A time in which we have to act quickly and actively. And not only in Lützerath, the village threatened by RWE at the Garzweiler 2 open-cast lignite mine.

Even before the cops show up with their destructive machines thugs the ZAD and in Rheinland, we have to act everywhere. Take to the streets; protest, rebel, sabotage, fight back everywhere, mobilise and educate others so that they took can act to evict. Learn skills and environment in the the Rhineland or in your city now to be able to act quickly and safely. We no longer ourselves to fight only on "small" scale. We have to break out of our (climate) bubble. We have to build bridges between workers, migrants, FLINTA and marginalised people capitalism, suffering from patriarchy and all other forms of discrimination.



For too long, the anarchist scene in this country (germany) has been standing in its own way. Kind of still hanging on the tip of the so-called left scene. Let's end this, because revolution is in the air, it is almost catchable and not only in the community in Lützerath. It only needs courageous rebels to give the impulse. Don't leave any police station or party office untouched, don't let any cars drive through the streets, block everything, lay down every job, go on strike. And not only if you work or live in an area affected by climate change. Question your privileges that often make it easier for you to survive in this world, because most people don't have them. It is up to all of us to make a difference. If we all pull together, the authorities can't stop us. Get together, organise, build social spaces and self-sufficiency. Organise education for yourselves and others. Address needs and fears and don't repress them as trivial fringe issues, because when we pay attention to our needs and overcome our fears we become invincible.

But we also need rebels to become part of the community in the ZAD Rheinland, whether in Unser aller Wald/Keyenberg, in the Hambacher Forest, in Lützerath or elsewhere in the area. Come by and

become part of the revolution here. We are trying to do things differently here, to try new steps. We want to question old structures and leave them behind so that we can try out new things. Here, in Lützerath, the struggle will be the hardest and it is not only a struggle against RWE, but a struggle that connects many perspectives of other social struggles. Struggles for housing and free spaces, struggles against discrimination and for justice, but also struggles for a new, self-determined life organised from below, in which everyone can participate. A life without capitalist exploitation and destruction.



Here, too, everything is far from perfect. We have to work on this together so that Lützerath does not only remain in people's minds as a climate occupation, but as a further step that takes place here every day in the process of revolution. We form friendships and bonds so that our community becomes stronger every day. We believe in revolution, we carry it in our hearts and live it a bit more every day.

Finally, we want to point out again that the struggles in ZAD Rheinland are not the only places of resistance. Many other forest squats are also under threat of eviction. Just like the few squats that exist in the so-called germany are also threatened again and again or struggle with the lack of capacity. Add to this the many struggles in other parts of the world that have understood what is at risk and are rebelling.

So join the struggles wherever they take place, this autumn must be hotter than hot. In doing so, let's lead the struggles intersectionally and support each other.
